FRANKLIN LOGISTICS PLANS MAJOR EXPANSION

Over 1.3 Million SF Warehouse & Crossdock in the Cumberland Valley Business Park on the PA & Southern

In our last issue we introduced you to our newest customer, Franklin Logistics and Development, one of the leading providers of warehouse, transloading, and transportation services in south central Pennsylvania. At the time Franklin Logistics had leased a 50,000 s/f, rail-served cross dock/warehouse in the Cumberland Valley Business Park (CVBP) to help serve its growing customer base. In this issue we are pleased to announce that Franklin Logistics has committed to our Chambersburg location by leasing 95 acres on Development Ave., adjacent to our Yard 2. The site will be the location of two to three new, state-of-the-art warehouse and crossdock facilities totaling over 1.3 million square feet of space under roof.

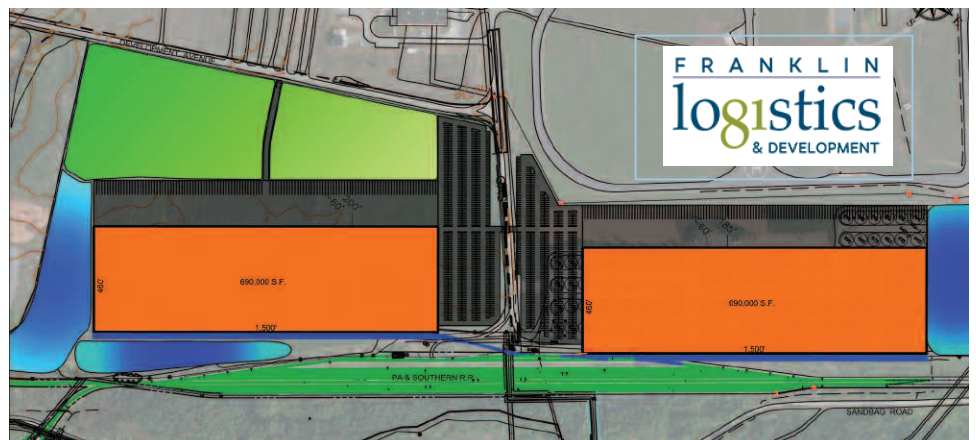
The services offered from Franklin Logistics' CVBP location will include warehousing, cross docking, and TL/LTL distribution. Each of the buildings will be rail served and will feature multiple tracks and carspots/rail doors allowing for the high-volume movement of a wide range of commodities. The facilities will be ideal for lumber, paper, building

materials, canned and bagged food, consumer products, birdseed, roofing products, and more.

The Pennsylvania & Southern will provide the new Franklin Logistics facilities with daily switching and a connection to CSX that will enable it to reach the entire North American marketplace. The adjacent Yard 2 will provide ample carspots for even the largest shipments.

The facility is strategically located in south central Pennsylvania and is within one day's trucking time to much of the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic. Truck routes in and out of the park lead to Interstate 81, the major north-south route connecting Harrisburg, PA (I-76, I-78) and Hagerstown, MD (I-70).

Raritan Central's Edison, NJ, Cross Dock Grows to Over 50,000 SF

The Raritan Central's 58 Northfield Ave. cross dock has expanded to offer shippers increased flexibility and services. The new Northfield Cross Dock Facility now includes space at adjacent 46 and 68 Northfield Ave. Combined, the facility offers over 50,000 SF of space served by 2 rail sidings, four rail doors, 12 truck doors, 2 ramps, and over 10 railcar spots.

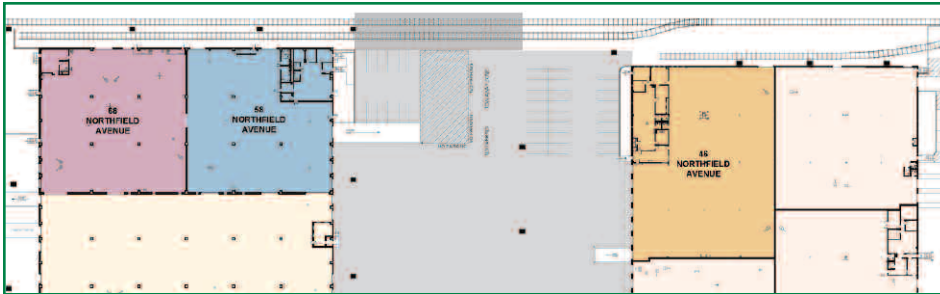
The facility is ideally suited for handling wine, canned goods, specialty hardwood lumber, lumber A-frames, gypsum board, paper, and more. Whether it is transferring between ship, rail, or truck, the Raritan Central's Northfield Cross Dock Facility can handle your shipment in a clean and efficient environment. It can unload, store, and distribute products closer to the end users, consistently providing them with on-time and damage-free deliveries.

The facility expansion also included a paving project between 46 and 58 Northfield which increased the types of materials as well as the

number of rail cars the facility can handle. Both the building siding and the adjacent running track have been paved flush to the rail, allowing forklifts a full 360 degree, obstruction-free access to railcars placed on the siding. This will enable items like lumber A-frames to be unloaded quickly and easily. The paving also provides two to three additional carspots on the running track.

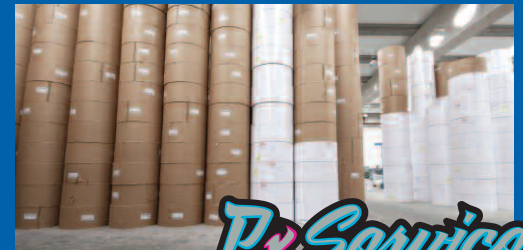


Raritan Central's two Class 1 rail connections, Norfolk Southern and CSX, give the facility competitive access to all of North America. Edison is only 15 miles from the Port of New York and New Jersey in Newark, providing complete entry to worldwide shipping lanes. For local and regional deliveries the facility has immediate access to I-95 as well as five other highways, providing one-day travel times to major markets from New England to the Mid-Atlantic. This summer crews were kept busy on many small track projects around Raritan Center. They ranged from tie replacement to surfacing of the park's running tracks and customer sidings. Receiving new ties were the siding to the Mayfield crossdock, the curve between the crossings on Clover Parkway, the Bamberger siding, and the very long San Remo track to the waterfront. The curve leading to the Mayfield Ave. area and the track to Del Express also received work.
